Responses after opponent's DBL:
Over X, we are no longer forced to game;
Pass by responder asks for opener's 2 nd suit.
XX = penalty.
New suit by responder = independent suit, natural, NF.
Responses after opponent's overcall:
We are still forced to game.
P = GF, nothing great in spades;
X by $us = penalty$.
Our bids = essentially the same as if they did not overcall $f(x) = \frac{1}{2} \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} dx$
Rebids after 4 th hand DBLs the response:
same as over X above; not forced to game any longer
Rebids after 4th hand overcalls : Same as after overcall above

Suggested Defense

X = Sound takeout of spades

 $4\clubsuit, 4\blacklozenge, 4\blacktriangledown$ = natural.

 $4 \bigstar = \text{minors}$, better clubs;

4NT=minors, better diamonds.

Pass, then X = Good balanced hand (about Strong NT).

Over the response: 3NT-p-4 or 4 : X=TO of spades, $4 \neq /4 \neq =$ natural.

After (3NT)-DBL: Bids natural, except 4 is minors, better clubs, 4NT is minors, better diamonds.

After (3NT)-P-(4X)-P; (P)-DBL: Bid naturally, except 4♠ if available is minors; 4NT Natural.

After (3NT)-4x-(P): 4 cue bid; others natural (including 4NT), NF.
